God showed Naaman his salvation. God shows us our salvation.

1. Naaman

- a. God enabled Naaman to be the commander of the army of Aram, but he had a problem.  
2 Kings 5:1.

- b. God brought a young Israelite girl into Naaman's life, who introduced him to God's prophet.  
2 Kings 5:2-3.

- c. Amazingly, Naaman listened to this foreign captive servant girl.

- d. God's provision of healing required Naaman to humble himself and trust in his word.
